We are offering five \$1,000 scholarships for women who are seeking re-entry or continuing of present education in a local college or trade school. The requirements for these scholarships are:

1. Applicant must be a resident of Ventura County or reside in Malibu, Westlake Village, or Agoura Hills if in Los Angeles County.
2. Proof of enrollment for current year or Letter of Acceptance from an Accredited Trade School or College for next enrollment period must be provided.
3. Completion of attached Application.
4. Availability for Interview by Zonta Scholarship Committee at designated date and time to be assigned each applicant as well as attendance by winner at presentation dinner. (Zonta pays for dinner for scholarship winners and their guest.)

Our mission is to improve the status of women worldwide. In an effort to achieve that mission, we invite all women to apply for these financial assistance scholarships. The awarding of the scholarships will be based not only on financial need; but also on the overall answers made in the application and the interview of each applicant.
