General Information

The goal of the Zonta International Young Women in Public Affairs (YWPA) Program is to encourage more young women to participate in public and political life by recognizing a commitment to the volunteer sector, evidence of volunteer leadership achievements and a dedication to the advancement of the status of women.

The Award

District recipients receive US\$500. Five International awards are selected from the District recipients to receive awards of US\$1,000 each.

Who is Eligible?

Applicants must be pre-university or pre-college students (age 16-20) at the time of application.

What are the Requirements?

Applications must show:

- ❑ Evidence of active commitment to volunteerism.
- ❑ Evidence of volunteer leadership achievements.
- ❑ Evidence of dedication to advancing the status of women worldwide.

How do I apply?

Complete an official application (may be printed or downloaded from the Zonta International Web site, www.zonta.org/ywpa); include, verification of current enrollment by school official, and two confidential recommendations from adults, not related to the applicant, such as teachers, school officials or community leaders. All application materials must be received at the Zonta Club by the printed deadline. If no Zonta Club contact information is printed on the upper left-hand side of the application, please locate a Zonta Club nearest you using the [Club Locator](#) at www.zonta.org, or e-mail your name and contact information to the Young Women in Public Affairs Coordinator at ywpaordinator@zonta.org. Please note that you must contact a Zonta Club before sending your application.

Supporting documentation not requested will not be considered. All applications and supporting information become the property of Zonta International. Zonta International has final authority over any aspect of the Awards.

What is the application process?

Applications selected by Zonta Clubs are sent to the Zonta District Governors. A District Evaluating Committee selects one applicant per district to submit to Zonta International Headquarters. The Zonta International Young Women in Public Affairs Subcommittee selects five international recipients from the District applications.

District recipient selected and application received by Zonta International Headquarters.....	by 1 May
Zonta International YWPA Committee recommends the International recipients.....	by 30 June
