We are offering five scholarships of \$1,000 each, for women over the age of 25, who are seeking re-entry or continuing of present education in a local college or trade school, after being at home caring for their family.

1. Applicant must be 25 years of age or older, and a resident of Ventura County, or reside in Malibu, Westlake Village, or Agoura Hills if in Los Angeles County.
2. Complete the attached Application and turn it in by the deadline. Applications are available on-line at www.zontacv.org.
3. Attach to the completed Application, proof of enrollment for the current year, or Letter of Acceptance from an Accredited Trade School or College for the next enrollment period. Attach any official or unofficial transcripts available. You may also attach a letter of recommendation but it is not a requirement.
4. Availability for Interview by the Zonta Club of the Conejo Valley Area Scholarship Committee at designated date, time and place, to be assigned each applicant, as well as attendance at the presentation dinner. (Zonta will pay for the presentation dinner of the scholarship winner and one guest.)

The deadline for applications is midnight, February 6th. Mail completed Applications to: Zonta Scholarships-WHW, 1791 Sutter Avenue, Simi Valley, CA. 93065. You may e-mail questions to scholarships@zontacv.org, or call (805) 527-7074.

Applications submitted after the deadline date will not be considered, so mail early. The awarding of the scholarships will be based not only on financial need, but also on the overall answers made in the application process, including the interview of each applicant.
